## **CONTEST RULES**

- 1. Fishing Hours begin at 4 a.m., and run approx. 5, 6 or 7 hours, depending on division:
- Solo anglers must be back into the harbor no later than 9:15 a.m.
- Two-person teams must be back into the harbor no later than 10:15 a.m.
- Three person teams must be back into the harbor no later than 11:15 a.m.
- 2. The tournament director has the right to delay or shorten the tournament, or postpone until the following day, if weather is a factor.
- 3. The tournament director and anyone else assisting or affiliated with the event are not responsible for any damage, liability, theft or loss that may result prior to, during or after the tournament. All team captains must read and sign the release of liability statement.
- 4. The tournament director has the right to refuse any fish that do not appear to be freshly caught on hook and line. All Wisconsin fishing rules and regulations apply.
- 5. There can be no physical contact between contestants or other vessels unless a tow is required. In that case, you must contact the tournament director and must still return by the required time for your division.
- 6. All teams must display their tournament flag on a part of the boat highly visible to other contestants and vessels during the entire tournament.
- 7. No team members can fish or be on the lake on July 6 after 6 p.m.
- 8. Only fishing team members are allowed on the boats.
- 9. All boats must launch or leave out of Algoma. Tournament boundaries are Wisconsin waters 10 miles north to 10 miles south of Algoma harbor.
- 10. Teams can weigh up to full limits (15, 10 or 5 fish). Random cooler/boat inspections may be made prior to launching, or on the water prior to the start.
- 11. Starting and returning procedures will be covered at the team meeting.
- 12. In addition to cash prizes for the top teams in each class and "King of Kings," prizes will be awarded to teams with the largest fish in each species. There will also be a mystery weight prize and some random draw prizes.
- 13. Each team captain has the right to file a protest within 30 minutes of final weighing. A \$30 fee must accompany all protests, and if the protest is found invalid, the fee will not be returned. A tournament committee will interpret the rules, and its decision is final.
